### KEY FACTS TO TAKE AWAY FROM THIS GENERAL ELECTION – NOV 2016

**Overall Turn out Rate 84% of Republicans** eligible to vote, did. Compared with County total rate of 76.52, REPs were the significant contributor to that OVERALL rate. 68% of Republicans voted by mail or early voted

Follow-up on Vote by Mail (Absentees) paid off, **TOTAL RETURN RATE 92%** . only 1106 of the 13570 requested were not returned( 8%)

**Citrus Co. delivered 54,377 votes for Trump**, so if every Republican registered voted for him , that means he received 5474 votes from DEMs and OTHERs though probably more . 68% of our voters supported Trump !

Citrus Co. **delivered 48,727 votes for Rubio** – Republicans held strong. 62% of our voters supported Rubio!.

Republicans locally now hold all constitutional offices but Superintendent, All County Commission Seats, 3 of our 5 school board members.
